This meeting was advertised in *The Record Herald* newspaper on February 21, 2017 for the purpose of accepting comments on the Borough of Waynesboro's proposed program modification to the FY 2015 Community Development program. Funds previously allocated to Demolition will instead be used for Handicap Barrier Removal at Borough Hall. A handicap lift at the pool will not be funded with CDBG funds. Funds in the amount of \$109,593 will be available for Borough Hall.

Kevin Grubbs, Head of Engineering Services, commented that drawings and estimates for proposed ADA renovations of the restrooms on the second floor of Borough Hall (near the Council Chambers and second floor conference room) were submitted to Mullin & Lonergan for review. Also provided was information regarding ADA accessibility modifications required to the front entry doors at the Police Department, and the doors leading to the back offices from Borough Hall's front lobby.

Comments from the public were requested. There being none, however, the meeting adjourned at 7:22 p.m.
