CONSIDER HIRING TWO (2) POLICE OFFICERS – WILLIAM SUBLETT & SHAWN TUTHILL: Chief Sourbier explained that William Sublett worked for Frederick City Police Department and is eligible to work in PA based on an Act 120 waiver.
