PUBLIC HEARING

The public hearing was called to order at 10:00 a.m. Borough Secretary Melinda Knott read the following:

“Under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES Act) dated March 27, 2020, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has allocated the Borough of Waynesboro \$77,454.00 in Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) funds to address needs resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.

The CDBG-CV programmatic requirements mirror those of the CDBG program unless specifically identified. At least 70% of the available funding must be used for activities that benefit low and moderate-income persons. The proposed activities must benefit at least 51% low-moderate income persons in the service area to qualify as a low-moderate income project.

The first of two (2) required public hearings was held on July 7th at 10:00 a.m. Notice was published in *The Record Herald* on July 9th that the Borough of Waynesboro would hold the second public hearing at this time.

The purpose of this hearing is to obtain additional comments regarding COVID-19 related needs and use of the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2020 Pennsylvania CDBG-CV funds.”

There being no members of the public in attendance to provide comments, the hearing was closed at 10:12 a.m.
