

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FFY 2016 & FFY 2017 CDBG PROGRAMS BUDGET MODIFICATION
BOROUGH OF WAYNESBORO**

Notice is hereby given by the Borough of Waynesboro that a Public Hearing will be held on Wednesday, February 13, 2019 at 4:00 P.M., prevailing time, in the second floor Council Chambers of Borough Hall, 55 East Main Street, Waynesboro, PA 17268. The Borough Hall is accessible to handicapped persons. Persons requiring special accommodation to participate in the public hearing may call the Borough Secretary's office at (717) 762-2101, Ext. 225, to make those arrangements. Persons with hearing and/or speech impediments may contact the Borough through the PA Telecommunications Relay Service at 1-800-654-5984, or 711 to make arrangements.

The purpose of the public hearing is to present and discuss proposed modifications to the Borough's FFY 2016 and FFY 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Programs. The Borough is proposing the following modifications:

FFY 2016

Reduce the budget amount for the Removal of Architectural Barriers/ADA Improvements to the Borough Building from \$112,301 to \$31,025.

Add a new activity to the CDBG Program entitled Street Improvements – South Price Avenue with a budget amount of \$81,276.

FFY 2017

Reduce the line item for the ADA Curb Cuts/Ramps Activity in the budget amount of \$110,560.

Add a new activity to the CDBG Program entitled Street Improvements – South Price Avenue with a budget amount of \$73,206.

The FFY 2016 and FFY 2017 CDBG funds for South Price Avenue will be combined with the FFY 2018 CDBG funds in the amount of \$124,358 for South Price Avenue for a total combined project budget of \$278,840.

All interested residents are encouraged to attend and will be afforded the opportunity to give oral testimony or to present written comments on the proposed modifications.
